Home Made Dog Treats

There's no better way to spoil the one you love than by baking homemade treats. Why should your dog be any different?

Ingredients:

- 2 ½ cups white flour (or whole wheat)
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 egg
- 1 chicken or beef stock cube
- ½ cup hot water
- baking sheet

Step 1:

Start by preheating your oven to 180°.

Put your stock cube in 1/2 a cup of boiling water to dissolve.

Step 2:

Put all the ingredients into a mixing bowl and stir until everything is combined.

Step 3:

Sprinkle some flour onto your work surface and roll out the dough. Then start cutting out your dog biscuits.

Step 4:

Place the dog biscuits on a tray and bake at 180 degrees for 30 minutes.



- Closed shoes must be worn while training.
- No smoking.
- It's your responsibility to supervise your children at all times.
- Dogs must be on a lead at all times, unless instructed otherwise.
- Membership badges must be worn.
- Remember to pick up after your dog. 6.

Doggy Etiquette

Please ensure you have full control of your dog at all times. Like humans, dogs need their personal space. Please check with other handlers before letting your dog approach another. Some timid dogs can be greatly stressed when boisterous dogs approach, sometimes causing aggression. Some of our dogs are still learning to be nice to each other and progress can be hindered after an unpleasant encounter. You may see a yellow ribbon or scarf used to indicate a very timid dog.

- Please remember to sign in at the table and pay your \$2 grounds fee to your instructor each week.
- Please clearly print your name (not your dog's!) and which class you are in to help with our records.
